We would like the children to come to school wearing 1940's/World War 2 attire, such as shorts and a shirt and tie, a dress or similar.

Costumes can be as simple as you wish; we do not expect you to purchase a costume especially for this. Please speak to Mr Wilson as soon as possible if you feel you may have difficulty providing a costume for your child.

On the day, the children will be given the experience of an evacuation and an opportunity to taste typical food from during the war whilst learning about life as an evacuee. If your child has any food allergies and you have not already notified us, please let Mr Wilson know by Monday 23rd November.
