School Places:

Over the past two days, there has been a great deal of media coverage regarding school places. As much as I would love to have all children in school, to ensure social distancing within the classrooms, this is not possible.

Remote Learning:

As a school we have been delighted to the high levels of engagement in remote learning this week. I recognise that there are new expectations compared to the March lockdown and the immense effort that has been evident this week has been fantastic.

As we move to new platforms and adapt our approaches, I know that there will be challenges. If you are unable to access a file, or resources, please make contact with the school so this can be rectified at the earliest opportunity. To enable us to ensure your child continues to have access to learning, the <u>Access</u> to technology questionnaire remains open.

Your child(ren) can also access Google Classroom via a Play Station or X Box device. Google Classroom can be accessed through the www. logo on each of these devices. If you cannot see this on the landing page, the app can easily be found. Additional information on how to do this can be found at the end of this newsletter. Connecting a USB keyboard will allow your child(ren) to complete learning activities with improved speed and 'turn in' completed documents.

Daily Tasks:

In addition to the lessons that your child(ren) are accessing, they are also expected to complete their daily tasks of reading and Numbots or Times Table Rock Stars. Early next week, we will upload videos to Class Dojo so all parents and carers are confident with how to access different aspects of each online platform.

Accessing Google Classroom via PlayStation or Xbox:



- 1. Turn on PS4
- Use your controller to scroll to the far right of the bar with games to Library
- 3. Select Library application
- Within the library use the search bar to type in Internet
- Select the Internet Browser app
- Start Internet Browser and press the triangle button on the controller to search
- 7. Once on the internet, type in the search box Google Classroom and select the first link that comes up:

Classroom: manage teaching and learning Google for Education - link below' https://edu.google.com/product s/classroom

Select Go to Classroom.
Then log in using student email and password.



- 1. Go to Home Menu
- 2. Select My Games and Apps
- 3. Scroll down to Apps
- 4. Go to *Microsoft Edge* application
- 5. Type in a search for Google Classroom
- 6. Select Go to Classroom
- You will need to log in using your student email address and password.

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
