Dear Parents and Carers

Year 6 Leavers Activities

We have now reached the final half term of the academic year and for our Year 6 children this will be their last half term with us. Sadly, the impact of COVID-19 has meant that we are unable to run our usual residential trip which would normally take place in July.

We are mindful that all children have missed out significantly because of the pandemic, both educationally and socially. We have therefore arranged some alternative events for our Year 6 children which will take place over the coming weeks:

Year 6 'Day of Fun' – Tuesday 13th July 2021:

We are pleased to confirm that Premier Sport will be running an activity day in school for our Year 6 children. The day will include events such as inflatable darts, tennis, archery and team challenges. **Children should come to school in PE kit on this day.**

Activity Session (Suzanne Hill) – Wednesday 14th July:

On Wednesday 14th July, Suzanne Hill will be coming in to school to run a session with Year 6. During the session the children will take part in drama-based activities, dance and party games. **Children should come to school in PE kit on this day.**

Please note: there will be no hot lunches available on this day. Please ensure your child brings a packed lunch. If you have already ordered and paid for a hot meal you will need to request a credit before 11.59pm on Sunday 4th July. A packed lunch will be ordered for any child who is eligible for Free School Meals.

Year 6 Campover – Friday 16th July:

Although we cannot offer a full residential trip this year, we would like to invite the children to a 'Campover' in the school grounds on Friday 16th July.

Children will remain at school at the end of the day. We will run games and activities during the evening followed by a take-away meal (chosen by the children) and a campfire.

Children will sleep in tents on the field, with 2 children per tent. In the morning, they will enjoy a cooked breakfast (or cereal and toast if your child would prefer this). **Children should be collected from school at 10.00am prompt.**

Although some of the activities have been subsidised, **due to funding restraints, we are unable to completely cover the cost of these activities.** You will see from the table above that the amount asked for only covers the cost for each child. We would never request more than the cost per child; no parent is ever subsidising another child.

Please note that although contribution is voluntary, we must point out that it is probable that these activities would not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute. If this should prove difficult, please contact the school office in confidence. If you are in receipt of income support or certain other benefits please contact the school office, so that payment options can be discussed.

We are unable to give refunds in the event that your child is unwell or unable to attend on the day of the trip. This includes if your child is required to self-isolate. However, if the trip is cancelled, a full refund will be given.

Attached to this letter is a kit list. All items should be brought in a small holdall and **MUST** be named. If you feel you may have difficulty providing any of the items listed, please contact the school office as soon as possible.

Campover - Parental Consent:

Please complete the attached consent form and the medical/dietary needs form. **All forms must be returned to school no later than Friday 2nd July 2021. Children without all the completed forms will be unable to participate.**

COVID Guidance/Risk Assessments:

Prior to these sessions taking place, an in-depth risk assessment will be carried out. As part of this process, current COVID-19 guidance will be checked and followed in accordance with Government and West Sussex County Council advice.
