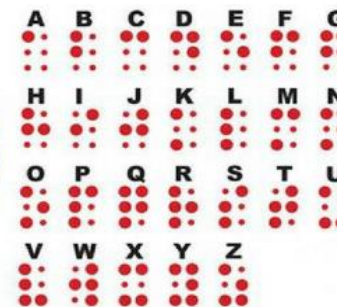
## What knowledge should I already have developed?

| Word        | Definition   |
|-------------|--|
| Persevere   | To continue in a task or hold steadfastly to a belief especially when it is difficult to do; persist |
| Equality    | Being equal or treated the same as someone else  |
| Blind       | Not able to see  |
| Segregation | To separate people according to groups, especially racial groups                                     |
| Racism      | The opinion or belief that a particular race of people is better than another race or races.         |
| Boycott     | To refuse to buy, use, or go to, in order to make a protest or bring about a change                  |
