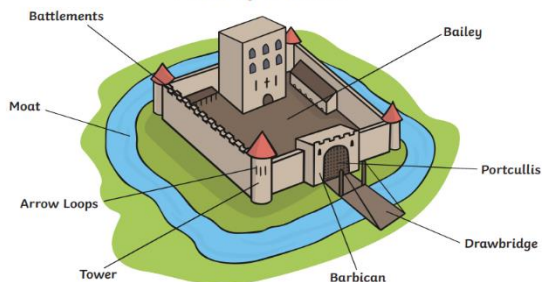
To help me answer the BIG question I will be learning...

Word	Definition
Attack	Take action with weapons.
British Isles	England, Northern Island, Scotland and Wales make up the British Isles.
Castle	A large building, typically of medieval period that has thick walls, battlements and towers.
Country	A land controlled by a single government.
Capital	A city or town where the government usually meets.
Defend	Resist an attack.
Location	A place or position.
Medieval	A historical period in England before the Great Fire of London.
Motte	The mound that a castle is built on.
Motte and bailey	A type of castle that had a fort on a motte surrounded by a bailey.
Turret	A small tower on top of a larger tower.
