
To support your child's learning this term, we have detailed below a breakdown of the planned trips and visits and the associated costs.

Due to funding restraints, we are unable to subsidise any trips or visits. You will see from the table above that the amount asked for only covers the cost for each child. We would never request more than the cost per child; no parent is ever subsidising another child. **Payment must be made via ParentMail PMX.**

Please note that although contribution is voluntary, we must point out that it is probable that these sessions could not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute. If this should prove difficult, please contact the school office in confidence. If you are in receipt of income support or certain other benefits please contact the school office in confidence, so that payment options can be discussed.

<u>Visit to the Mary Rose Museum (Portsmouth Historic Dockyard) – Thursday 18th November:</u>
During the visit, the children will tour the museum and then take part in a 'Henry's Heroes' workshop, which will support them in learning more about what life was like below decks on King Henry VIII's warship. They will then visit the Mary Rose itself, which is has been on display since it was recovered



















from the seabed in 1982. More information about the museum and the Mary Rose itself can be found at: https://maryrose.org/.

We will be travelling to and from the dockyard by coach. We will be departing from school promptly at 9.00am, therefore all children must arrive at school by 8.40am. We will return to school in time for the normal end of the school day. Payment for this trip is due by 18th October 2021.

Swimming Lessons:

Children will receive a weekly swimming lesson at The Arena on Monday afternoons, as follows:

First lesson: Monday 15th November 2021 Last lesson: Monday 13th December 2021

TOTAL: 5 lessons

The cost of the lessons will be £3.60 per child per week. The total cost per child will be £18.00 for 5 weeks. This cost includes pool hire, lifeguard and instructors and insurance. To keep costs to a minimum, we will be walking to and from The Arena for these sessions.
