### Payment:

Payment of **£15.31** is due by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022, via ParentMail. Due to funding restraints, we are unable to subsidise any trips or visits. You will see from the table above that the amount asked for only covers the cost for each child. We would never request more than the cost per child; no parent is ever subsidising another child.

**Please note that although contribution is voluntary, we must point out that it is probable that these sessions could not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute.** If this should prove difficult, please contact the school office in confidence. If you are in receipt of income support or certain other benefits please contact the school office in confidence, so that payment options can be discussed.

### Transport:

We will be travelling to the venue by coach. Children should arrive at school at the normal time ready for registration before we leave.

### Lunches:

**A packed lunch will be ordered for all children eligible for Income Based Free School Meals**, unless you tell us you do not want this. In this case you will need to provide a packed lunch for your child (please note nuts or nut products and fizzy drinks are not permitted).

Any child who is not eligible for Free School Meals will be required to bring a packed lunch. **If you have already ordered and paid for a hot meal on this date, you must request a credit no later than 11.59pm on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2022, by visiting [www.mealselector.co.uk](http://www.mealselector.co.uk).**

### What to bring:

All children must wear full school uniform. Please also ensure your child has a warm waterproof coat and a small backpack to carry their lunch and belongings. All children must bring a refillable water bottle.

### Parental Consent:

This visit is covered by the generic consent for trips and visits, which you signed when your child started at the school, so there is no requirement for you to complete an additional consent form.

### Travel Sickness:

If your child is prone to travel sickness and will require travel sickness medication, please administer this before school. Medication required for the journey home can be administered by school staff if required, but must be age appropriate and supplied by the parent/guardian in its original packaging. **Please speak to the school office no later than the week before the visit if your child will require travel sickness medication.**

### Parent Helpers:

We will require some parent helpers for this visit. Please note that all helpers will be subject to a DBS check. As DBS checks can take a few weeks to process, we encourage you to contact the school office at the earliest opportunity if you think you may be able to help with this visit.
