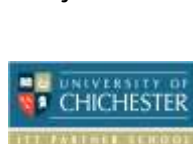
**Due to funding restraints, we are unable to subsidise any trips or visits.** You will see from the table above that the amount asked for only covers the cost for each child. We would never request more than the cost per child; no parent is ever subsidising another child. **Payment must be made via ParentMail PMX.**

**Please note that although contribution is voluntary, we must point out that it is probable that these sessions could not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute.** If this should prove difficult, please contact the school office in confidence. If you are in receipt of income support or certain other benefits please contact the school office in confidence, so that payment options can be discussed.

### Visit to the RNLI Lifeboat Station in Littlehampton – Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June:

As part of our Big Question *'Should we treat the sea with caution or curiosity?'*, pupils will discuss and understand the social and emotional effects of disasters at sea.

We will be travelling to and from Littlehampton by train and we will depart and return to school during the normal school day. **Payment of £3.05 per child is due by Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022.**

#### Swimming Lessons:

Children will receive a weekly swimming lesson at The Arena on Wednesday afternoons, as follows:

First lesson: Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2022  
Last lesson: Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2022  
(NO SESSION ON 1<sup>ST</sup> JUNE – HALF TERM)  
**TOTAL: 5 lessons**

The cost of the lessons will be **£3.60** per child per week. The total cost per child will be **£18.00 for 5 weeks**. This cost includes pool hire, lifeguard and instructors and insurance. To keep costs to a minimum, we will be walking to and from The Arena for these sessions.

#### Lunches – Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June:

For the visit to the RNLI Lifeboat Station, a packed lunch will be ordered for all children eligible for Free School Meals.

If your child is not eligible for Free School Meals you must provide a packed lunch on this date. **If you have already ordered and paid for a hot lunch for 29<sup>th</sup> June, you can request a credit by visiting [www.mealselector.co.uk](http://www.mealselector.co.uk). The latest date to request a credit is 23.59pm on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> June.**

#### Parent/Carer Helpers:

We will require some helpers as follows:

**Swimming** – walking to and from the swimming pool. Please note that for safeguarding reasons parents and carers would not be able to enter the pool area during the session. If you are able to help with any or all of the sessions please let the school office know.

**RNLI visit** – we will require 3 helpers for this visit. Please contact the school office if you are able to help.

Please note, you must have a DBS check in place to help with either visit – this can be arranged by the school. Please let us know if you would like to complete a DBS check.

Parental Consent:

The visit to the RNLI Lifeboat Station is covered by the generic consent for trips and visits, which you signed when your child started at the school, so there is no requirement for you to complete an additional consent form. In the event of an emergency, we would use the emergency contact information we have on file for your child. **Please notify us immediately if there has been any change to this information.**

However, for swimming sessions, a consent form is required. **Please complete the attached form and return it to school no later than Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April.**
