Parking:

Toilet facilities will be available in the main foyer (near the office). For safeguarding reasons, we request that parents and carers only enter the school building to use the toilets, using the doors from the Key Stage 1 playground.

Young Children/Climbing Apparatus:

Please keep any younger children with you at all times. Please note that the climbing equipment will be out of use throughout the event.

Timings:

The main gates will open at 2.05pm. They will close promptly at 2.15pm. All visitors must sign in on arrival. We ask for your co-operation by arriving on time.


