How you can help your child

Literacy at home

Encourage the children to talk about the story that we are focussing on that week. Can they retell it to you? Can they write a sentence for a part of the story e.g. The bear went to the moon. We should now be remembering to put a full stop at the end of our sentences and finger spaces between words. Children should now be getting more confident at blending in their own reading books and also recognising lots more tricky words. Can they talk about what they have just read to you? Do they understand what happened in the story?

Maths at home

To support with our doubling, halving and sharing focus this half term you could support your child by practising this with everyday objects in your home. For example, sharing out sweets equally between themselves and someone else or questioning your child when they are playing e.g. "If I have 2 cars, how many will I have if I have 2 more?" Please continue to share learning at home with Miss Stanton via the class dojo system.

Vocabulary

It would be really helpful if you could talk about these words with your child so that they become familiar with them.
