## **Prayer Space:**

Last week, pupils across the school engaged in a Prayer Space at St Mary Magdalene Church. Prayer spaces provide pupils with the opportunity to reflect on life's big questions and to develop their spirituality. At the church, pupils had the opportunity to visit a range of prayer stations which prompted pupils to reflect on local and international topics. Pupils responded with curiosity and maturity to the adults and stations.

'It was so cool because we got to use sand to write a prayer to others' (Year 2)

'I enjoyed it because I thought about people in other countries including the Ukraine' (Year 2)

'I enjoyed creating the bracelets because I could think about the people that are important to me' (Year 4)

'There were different activities that allowed us to express our feelings. We were able to share any worries we have' (Year 5)

'I enjoyed visiting the sand station because it allowed me the opportunity to express the things that I am sorry for' (Year 6)

'Visiting the forgiveness well gave me the opportunity to let go and forgive' (Year 6)









### **Year 6 National Curriculum Assessments:**

Over the past two weeks, pupils in Years 2 and 6 have been completing a range of assessments. We are incredibly proud of the children's positive attitude and determination in sharing what they have learnt.

## **Sporting Success:**

On Wednesday, some of our Year 4 pupils competed at a Quadkids Athletics competition at The Regis School. The children competed as a team across four athletic events - 50m Sprint, Vortex throw, standing long jump and a 400m sprint. All our pupils competed well, showing great determination and competitiveness. We are waiting for the results to be published and will share these when they are available:

'On Tuesday afternoon we went to the Quadkids event at the Arena. There were 8 of us. We took part in four events that were two lots of running, jumping and throwing. I really liked it because it was a lot of exercise and really fun. My favourite was the big jump because I got to find out how far I could jump' (Isla J, Y4)

'My favourite part was the sprint because you get to run around, it doesn't matter how fast you are because the most important thing was having fun' (Maisie P, Y4)

'The 400 metre run was really challenging and at the end you felt really tired' (Fred N, Y4)

'I liked the throwing event because it was a challenge to see who could throw it the furthest' (Maya D-C, Y4)

Yesterday, some of our Year 6 pupils took part in an Orienteering Festival at The Regis School. During the event the children participated in 3 activities, a competitive orienteering race, a team building task and a blind obstacle course. Our pupils enjoyed the event and were able to use their previous knowledge of orienteering to help them.

## **Year 3 and 4 Guinness World Record Attempt:**

On Wednesday morning, Year 3 and Year 4 took part in TTRockstars National Numeracy Day Live Streaming Guinness World Record attempt! TTRockstars were aiming to create the biggest live streaming of a number roll (times table recital). This was officially supported by Guinness World Records. The existing record of 1500 was smashed with over 5000 views, of which we were a part. The children really enjoyed themselves and were proud to be part of this attempt.
