Year 2 – end of Universal Infant Free School Meals entitlement:

A reminder to all current Year 2 parents and carers that the Universal Infant Free School Meals programme ends at the end of Year 2. Therefore, if you would like your child to continue having a hot lunch in school you will need to register with our meal provider (<u>www.mealselector.co.uk</u>) and order your meals for each week (meals are currently £2.33 per day). Meals must be ordered 10 days in advance.

However, if your child is eligible for Income Based Free School Meals, your child will continue to receive a free meal daily (unless you tell us you do not want this) – free meals are ordered by the school. If you think you may be eligible for Income Based Free School Meals and have not yet applied, please find more information about how to do this attached to this Friday Flyer.
