Word	Definition
Antarctica	<i>The most southerly of the Earth's continents</i>
Crew	<i>A group of people who work on and operate a ship or aircraft</i>
Endurance	<i>Being able to endure an unpleasant or difficult process or situation without giving up; The name of Ernest Shackleton's ship</i>
Expedition	<i>A journey undertaken by a group of people with a particular purpose, especially to explore or to research</i>
Explorer	<i>A person who travels to and tries to find out about a new or unfamiliar area</i>
Leadership	<i>The action and skills of leading a group of people</i>
Persuade	<i>To cause someone to do something through reasoning or argument.</i>
Source	<i>Documents, artefacts, archaeological sites, paintings, photographs, video clips and similar things from which we can learn about the past</i>
Voyage	<i>A long journey involving travel by sea or in space</i>
