Henry VII



Henry VII was the first Tudor monarch. After winning the Battle of Bosworth he married Elizabeth of York, who was the daughter of Edward IV.

Henry VIII



Henry VIII is famous for having six wives. He brought England away from the Catholic Church and became head of the Church of England.

Edward VI



Edward VI became King at the age of 9. He died at the age of 15. His mother was Jane Seymour.

Mary 1



Mary I was Henry VIII's first daughter – her mother was Catherine of Aragon.

Elizabeth 1



Henry VIII's second daughter. She had a long and successful reign. One of her achievements was to defeat the Spanish Armada.

Act of supremacy	Established Henry VIII has head of the Church of England
Battle of Bosworth	The last battle between the House of York and House of Lancaster.
Church of England	Henry VIII became the head of the Church of England.
Heir	The next in line to become King or Queen.
Monarch	A sovereign head of state; a king, queen or emperor.
Mary Rose	Henry VIII's favourite war ship named after his niece.
Treason	The crime of betraying your country.
Tudor Rose	The combination of the Rose of Lancaster and the Rose of York
