Henry VII	Henry VII was the first Tudor monarch. After winning the Battle of Bosworth he married Elizabeth of York, who was the daughter of Edward IV.
Henry VIII	Henry VIII is famous for having six wives. He brought England away from the Catholic Church and became head of the Church of England.
Edward VI	Edward VI became King at the age of 9. He died at the age of 15. His mother was Jane Seymour.
Mary 1	Mary I was Henry VIII's first daughter – her mother was Catherine of Aragon.
Elizabeth 1	Henry VIII's second daughter. She had a long and successful reign. One of her achievements was to defeat the Spanish Amada.
