Home Learning:

Each Friday, pupils will receive their home learning with the expectation that it is handed in no later than the following Wednesday. Each week, pupils will receive their spellings and a maths task, and a whole school task every other week. There is also an expectation that your child will participate in the Times Table Rock Stars Battle or Numbots and will also read daily.

Pupils in Key Stage 1, will receive their home learning via Class Dojo.

Pupils in Key Stage 2, will receive their home learning via Google Classroom.

Spellings:

In Years 2–6, children receive 10 spellings each week and in Year 1 they will receive 6. All children are tested on their words on a Wednesday or Thursday. If they are able to spell a word correctly, pupils will receive a new word for the following week.

Reading:

As a school, we recognise the importance of daily reading and encourage all children to read regularly. When listening to your child read, please write in their Reading Record.
