Word	Definition
island	A piece of land surrounded by water
British Isles	England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales make up the British Isles.
capital	A city or town where the government usually meets.
Caribbean	The region of the Caribbean Sea and its islands
compare	To identify similarities and differences between things
country	A land controlled by a single government.
continent	A continuous expanse of land covering more than one country
human feature	Geographical features made or influenced by people
location	A place or position.
ocean	A large expanse of sea
physical Feature	Naturally occurring features of the world around us
