Home Learning Challenge – Time:

The current Home Learning Challenge is linked to Time. The expectations for each year group are included on the attached flyer.

For Years 5 and 6, there is a specific challenge which children should complete. Children should present their findings and hand their work in by **Wednesday 14th December**.

Christmas Film Night – Monday 5th December:

On Monday, the first of our two film nights will take place (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2). If your child is attending this event, please collect promptly at 5.30pm.

If you have had difficulty paying for your child's ticket via ParentMail, on this occasion we can take cash payments. Please bring the money to the office by Monday morning.

Please note you **MUST** complete a consent form if your child is attending this event – if you have not yet done so please contact the school office. **Any child who does not have a completed consent form will unfortunately not be able to attend. We have sent home duplicate forms today with any child who does not yet have one completed.**

Year 6 Residential:

A reminder that the £40 deposit for the Year 6 residential in July was due by 23rd November 2022. If you feel you may have difficulty making payments for this trip, we strongly encourage you to speak to the school office, in confidence, as soon as possible.

Chartwells Christmas Dinner:

A reminder that our Chartwells Christmas Lunch will take place on **Thursday 15th December**. The ordering deadline for Years R, 1 and 2 and all Free School Meals children has now passed. However, if your child is in Years 3-6 and is not eligible for income based Free School Meals, you can still order a Christmas meal until 11.59pm on Sunday 4th December (www.mealselector.co.uk).

Reminder - Christmas Jumper Day:

A reminder that we will be having a Christmas Jumper Day on Thursday 15th December and Friday 16th December (to coincide with both grotto days).

We do have a number of Christmas jumpers in school which we can lend to children who do not have one – if you need to borrow a jumper for your child please let us know as soon as possible and confirm what size you may need, and we will check to see if we can help.

Likewise, if you have good condition jumpers you no longer need and would be willing to donate them, please let the school office know. We are particularly in need of larger sized boys jumpers.

Key Stage 2 Carol Service:

There are a number of children who have said they would like to join the Key Stage 2 Carol Service on Thursday 15th December. If your child would like to take part and you have not already completed the Google form, please send a dojo to the school office as soon as possible to confirm this, and also to let us know how many adults will be attending.

New Meal Ordering Process:

In early January, we will be moving to a new meal ordering service. Once this goes live, we will no longer be able to order any hot meals for children and the responsibility will be with the parent or

carer. This includes for all children in Years R, 1 and 2 and all Free School Meals children. Meals will need to be ordered by the parent or carer, via a ParentPay account.

An information sheet will be sent out today with some more information about this new process. After Christmas, instructions on how to access your ParentPay account will be sent home.

Christmas Raffle:
