**Lunch Ordering – ParentPay:**

The deadline for placing lunch orders via the new ParentPay ordering system is Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> February, for lunches to be eaten from Monday 20<sup>th</sup> February onwards.

If you have not yet done so, you must log in to your ParentPay account by 9<sup>th</sup> February, and select which meals your child would like to eat each day from 20<sup>th</sup> February. If you do not select meals for your child, he/she will only be able to have a jacket potato for lunch from 20<sup>th</sup> February onwards.
