

Whole School Home Learning Challenge:

Our latest home learning challenge is an Easter bonnet competition. For this challenge, children should design and create an Easter bonnet. Bonnets should be brought to school on Thursday 30th March (please do make sure your child's name is inside!).

The Friends of South Bersted will choose a winner for Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 at the end of the day. Children may then wear their Easter bonnet to the church service on Friday 31st March, if they wish.

Church Service – Friday 31st March:

Our end of term church service will take place on **Friday 31**st **March.** Parents and carers are invited to join us for this service at 9.00am. We will be having a non-uniform day on Friday 24th March. Children may wear non-uniform on this date in return for a donation of chocolate for our Easter fair. Chocolate should be brought to school on Wednesday 29th March and Thursday 30th March and should be handed to your child's class teacher.
