Due to funding restraints, we are unable to subsidise any trips or visits. You will see from the table above that the amount asked for only covers the cost for each child. We would never request more than the cost per child; no parent is ever subsidising another child. Payment must be made via MCAS.

### Chichester Planetarium – Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2023:

To support our Big Question of 'What does the future of space exploration look like?' we will be visiting the Chichester Planetarium. We will be travelling to the planetarium by train. Children should arrive at school at the normal time of 8.45am. We will be departing from school at 9.15am prompt and will catch the 10.05am train from Bognor Regis, returning in time for the end of the school day. Children should wear full school uniform. All children must also bring a water bottle and a small rucksack. Payment for this trip is due by 9<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

## <u>Visit to Ford Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) – Monday 6<sup>th</sup> November:</u>

To support our Big Question of 'Are We Destroying Our Planet' we will be visiting the Ford Materials Recycling Facility (MRF). During our visit, we will see how waste materials are recycled and processed in West Sussex and we will learn ways to improve our own recycling processes at home. We will be travelling to and from the MRF by coach. Children should wear full school uniform. All children must also bring a water bottle and a small rucksack. **Payment for this trip is due by 30**th **October 2023.** 

Please note that all children must have their legs fully covered during this visit – it is therefore very important that all children wear trousers, (leggings or tights may be worn under skirts) on this day. Children not dressed correctly will <u>not</u> be able to take part in the tour.

Please note that during the tour of the MRF, all children and staff will be required to wear PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) - this will comprise of a high-visibility vest, a hard hat, communication headset, safety glasses and gloves. Please discuss this with your child in advance so they are aware.

## For Chichester Planetarium;

If your child <u>is</u> eligible for Free School Meals or Universal Infant Free School Meals: You must log in to your ParentPay account and amend your order by 11.59pm on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October. If you would like the school to provide a free packed lunch for your child on this date, please select 'Chartwells Trip Lunch'. If you would prefer to provide your own packed lunch on this date, please ensure your child brings it with them on the day of the trip.

If your child is <u>NOT</u> eligible for Free School Meals, please provide them with a packed lunch.

#### For Ford MRF;

If your child <u>is</u> eligible for Free School Meals or Universal Infant Free School Meals: You must log in to your ParentPay account and amend your order by 11.59pm on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> October. If you would like the school to provide a free packed lunch for your child on this date, please select 'Chartwells Trip Lunch'. If you would prefer to provide your own packed lunch on this date, please ensure your child brings it with them on the day of the trip.

If your child is <u>NOT</u> eligible for Free School Meals, please provide them with a packed lunch.

Both visits are covered by the generic consent for trips and visits, which you signed when your child started at the school, so there is no requirement for you to complete an additional consent form. In the event of an emergency, we would use the emergency contact information we have on file for your child. Please notify us immediately if there has been any change to this information.
