YOUNG VOICES CONCERT:

As a school, we are looking at offering pupils in Years 4, 5 and 6 the opportunity to perform in the Young Voices Concert at the O2 Arena in London.

The trip takes places in January (either the 15th or 30th January) and pupils would leave school in the morning and return to school at around midnight. (The exact date cannot be confirmed until we book tickets).

This is a fantastic opportunity and if we were able to go ahead with this trip, we would look at offering it every three years. As the trip is extra-curricular, it would have to be paid in full by parents and carers.

The cost per child is £84 and the payment would have to be made in full by <u>Friday 15th December</u> (the last day of term). There are 30 places available.
