WASTEBUSTERS:

We are taking part in the Wastebusters Recycle to Read scheme, help us to gain points towards books for our school library by recycling your old toys. Its easy to do just follow the steps below.

1. You and your family help protect the planet by finding new homes for your unwanted toys and recycling broken, hard plastic toys, in our collection bins in participating Tesco stores.

RECYCLE: Take any small, broken, hard plastic toys to put in one of our recycling bins in a participating Tesco store. Then claim your Planet Care Point by telling us how many toys you've recycled.

Important! Scan the QR code on the bin to tell us about your recycling and you'll be entered into our prize draw!

REHOME: Find a new home for toys you don't play with anymore by giving them away to friends, family, charities, or toy sales. Then claim your Planet Care Point by telling us how many toys you've rehomed.

Upload a photo of the toys you have rehomed to be entered into our prize draw!

2. Tell us what you've done, by registering your toy rehoming and recycling and you'll earn Planet Care Points for your school. Go to [Recycle to Read | Get books for your school](#) to register and for more information.

3. The more points your school collects on the School Leader board, the more books they have a chance of getting!
