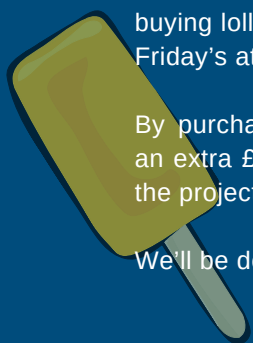
Entry this year will be exclusively online allowing friends and relatives to easily participate
