FLOWERING THE CROSS:

One of our Easter traditions, is the flowering of the cross. We take our Christmas tree and cut it down to create a cross using the trunk of the tree. The cross is then covered with wire so children can decorate the cross with fresh flowers. The transformation of a barren cross reminds us of Jesus' death on Good Friday and his resurrection on Easter Sunday.

We invite the children to decorate the cross by Key Stage, over two days. **Please bring the fresh flowers on the morning of Wednesday 27th March.**
