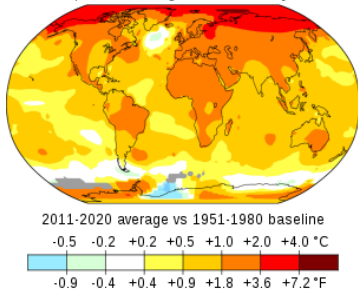


*How can we sustain the world we live in?***What should I already know?**

Word	Definition
Climate change	<i>A change in world climate with more extreme weathers</i>
deforestation	<i>Cutting down of trees and forests for timber or to free land for other purposes</i>
environment	<i>The area in which an animal, human or plant lives</i>
Fossil fuels	<i>Fuel sources such as coal and oil</i>
Global warming	<i>The increase in global temperatures as a result of climate change</i>
Greenhouse gases	<i>Harmful gases such as CO2 which is adding to the greenhouse effect (harming the ozone layer and trapping excess heat)</i>
Pollution	<i>Harmful substances being released into the environment</i>
Recycling	<i>The process of converting waste into reusable material</i>
Renewable energy	<i>Energy that comes from sustainable sources such as wind, solar or hydroelectric</i>
sustainable	<i>Something that can be maintained at a certain rate</i>

Population	<i>Approximately 7.9 billion</i>
Continents	<i>Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America, South America</i>
Oceans	<i>Arctic Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Southern Ocean</i>
Countries	<i>There are 195 countries on planet Earth</i>
Environments	<i>Forests (31%), Rainforests (2%), Deserts (33%)</i>
